

LIBRARY ACQUISITION GRANTS PROGRAM PURPOSE

The Library Acquisition Grants Program is intended to augment library acquisitions in several areas:

- areas that are relatively weak and need to be brought up to basic levels for a research university;
- areas that may be strong but where acquisitions of unique materials could boost research in key areas of scholarship to a higher level; or
- to respond to unique situations in which previously unavailable library materials will provide major new primary resources that will significantly augment research capabilities at Notre Dame.

This program is not meant to replace or be a substitute for the normal means of enhancing the library’s collections, but to provide a means of responding to unique opportunities.
